While enrolled in SPE 310 and LTC 318 (Complete with a B minimum grade): Admission to Teacher Education Program will be granted when you meet the following Criteria:

- 30+ hours of college credit
- COM 115 minimum grade C
- EDU 202 minimum grade B
- Passing score on approved Entrance Exam (ONE of the following)
 - O MoGEA: Math, Reading, AND Writing score of 167
 - O ACT Composite or Superscore: 17
 - O SAT Composite or Superscore: 920
 - O Paraprofessional Test: 220
 - O Elem Ed MoCA: 220
- MOVECHS Waiver: Found at My Missouri State > Teacher Education Resources box/card > MOVECHS Waiver
 - Complete Fingerprinting following instructions found on MOVECHS waiver (cost is \$41.75)
- Complete Professionalism Contract: Found at My Missouri State > Teacher Education Resources box/card
- Complete Student Contract: Found at My Missouri State > Teacher Education Resources box/card
- Complete Dispositions Traits Self-Assessment (will be sent to your MSU email account)
