Use of Social Security Number

Disclosure of your social security number is voluntary. If you provide your number, it will NOT appear on your student identification card but it is necessary for several University offices, including Financial Aid.

Residence for Fee Purposes

In determining a student's residency for tuition and fee purposes, the University adheres to the policy for determination of student residency (https://www.sos.mo.gov/cmsimages/adrules/csr/current/6csr/6c10-3.pdf) established and approved by the Missouri Coordinating Board of Higher Education (CBHE). The University also complies with all applicable federal and state laws and regulations with respect to the classification of veterans and their dependents. A student's residence status is determined at the time of admission. Students classified as non-residents who wish to apply for reclassification to resident status may do so by submitting a residency application to the Office of Admissions.

Academic Majors and Programs

Degree-seeking students are eligible to apply for financial aid. Some certificates are financial aid-eligible. Contact the Financial Aid Office to discuss funding options for certificates. Listed on the last page are the academic majors available at Missouri State-West Plains. Within some majors, you must specify which option within that major that you plan to pursue. Please write your intended major and option (if applicable). Admission to the University does not guarantee admission to specific majors. Students should refer to the University catalog at wp.missouristate.edu/catalog for program admission requirements, including specific application deadlines.

Nondegree-seeking Students

- Nondegree. Students 18 years of age and older or a high school graduate may apply under this classification.
 Transcripts are not required. Enrollment while in this category is limited to eight credit hours per semester to a total of 24 hours. Students are not eligible for financial aid while in this classification. (Course prerequisites apply)
- Nondegree Post Baccalaureate. Students who have a
 bachelor's degree and who wish to enroll in up to a full
 time course load with no restrictions on total hours may
 apply under this classification. Proof of bachelor's degree
 is required. Students in this classification are not eligible
 for financial aid. (Course prerequisites apply)
- Completion Program. Students who have completed an associate degree at Missouri State University-West Plains and wish to take additional Missouri State University-West Plains courses in pursuit of a bachelor's degree through Missouri State University-Springfield are eligible to apply under this classification. Students in this classification are eligible to apply for financial aid but must contact the Financial Aid Office for procedure. Contact Missouri State University Outreach at 417-255-7931 regarding admission and degree program requirements, and the bachelor's degrees offered by Missouri State University-Springfield at Missouri State University-West Plains.

AREAS OF STUDY

Associate of Arts Degree (AA)

Designed for those intending to transfer to a four-year college, majoring in areas such as the arts, humanities, social sciences, education or general studies. Associate of Applied Science Degree (AAS)

A specialized degree that is primarily an occupationally oriented degree, the AAS allows recipients of this degree to enter a particular job market. While not designed as transfer degrees, some AAS degrees can be used as the first two years of a Bachelor of Applied Science degree; however, students will need to take additional general education courses, as well as courses in the major field.
