The group's goal is to provide activities and programs to assist Missouri State-West Plains students in their development as leaders, scholars and future alumni who are proud to be Grizzlies.

Officer Scholarships

When available, the president and vice-president of FAO receive scholarships thanks to donations from Philanthropic Women for Education. The FAO president receives a \$300 scholarship award and the vice-president, \$200.

Officer Requirements

The FAO president will be a returning Missouri State-West Plains student who has earned a minimum of 18 credit-hours as of the end of May 2017. The vice-president will be an incoming freshman. FAO officers should be outgoing with a positive attitude, good leadership skills, excellent verbal/written communication skills, ability to multi-task, good time-management skills and social-media savvy. Other requirements include:

- Full-time student preferred or a student who is enrolled in a minimum of 9 credit-hours per semester
- 2.5 cumulative GPA or higher
- Be able to commit an hour a week for club meetings and an hour a week to meet with the assistant director of development for updates and planning purposes
- Be able to commit additional time to volunteer for alumni events, plan and implement FAO events and represent Missouri State-West Plains
- Cannot hold a position in a different student organization with equal or more responsibilities
