Degree Program Revisions

 - a. **AS Agriculture-posted in experts-** Reduce general education to 42- hour block as required by the state of Missouri and increase AGR classes to 15 hours.

 - b. **AS Business –posted in experts-** This proposal is to move two courses, Microeconomics (AGR 144) and Intro to Financial Accounting (ACC 201)

 - c. **AA Health Professions- Posted in experts ;** additional emphasis areas added (Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Radiography), change in credit hours due to ALH 116 credit hour change from 2 to 3 credit hours and oversight of CHM 161 lab needed to progress to CHM .

- VI. **Old Business**
 - a. **March 2016 Action: “or Completion of College Readiness Program” addition to all courses with prerequisite “C or better in IDS 150”**
There has been no follow-up regarding this action.
 - b. **March 2016 Recommendation regarding discussion of English Self-Placement** impact on some courses with “ENG 110 eligibility” prerequisite be brought to Faculty Senate. **Presented to Faculty Senate but no action taken.**

Current Curriculum Committee Recommendation: each division review courses that require “eligibility for ENG 110” and determine individually if a change in the prerequisite should read “completion of ENG 110 with C or better”. If so, proposals should be sent to Curriculum Committee using standard procedures.

 - a. **Committee unanimously supported Leigh Adams as the volunteer to represent the Curriculum Committee** in collaborating with the Assessment Committee to close the loop in the assessment and program review process.
