The Director's Corner

Greetings!

As summer starts to wane and we look forward to the coming of fall, the sounds of students chatting, books closing, and papers rustling reminds us that the semester is back in full swing. In April I was privileged to speak at the Friends final meeting for 2021-2022 and give an update on what Garnett Library staff had been up to all year. At this meeting we also held a dedication of the bench placed in front of the library in memory of Sylvia Kuhlmeier, director of library services 2009-2019.

Over the summer, the Garnett Library staff finished inventorying the library's physical collections as well as right-sizing the collection to make it a more user-friendly, optimally sized, and attractive collection. This task along with the diversity audit that is currently in progress allows the library to meet the needs of users while creating a diverse and inclusive collection.

Electronic resources continue to strengthen the Garnett Library collections. We added the Bloom's Literary Criticism eBook Collection of over 1,000 titles. This collection was created by Infobase as a tribute to the late, great Harold Bloom (world renowned as one of the best literary



criticists). We also added the Mometrix eLibrary, an online learning and test prep platform, to our database offerings. This database provides users with test preparation materials that are continually updated, and new tests are added on an ongoing basis.

I would like to give a big shoutout to our Assistant Librarian, Neva Parrott, as she celebrates 52 years of service to our library on September 1, 2022. Thank you, Neva, for all you do to keep the library, and me, on track!!!!
