We hope that you will give your support to each of them by your vote at the meeting on Friday. Installation will be at our next general meeting on April 14th. Thank you!



location. We want to introduce you to another building on campus — Drago Hall located on the corner of West Main and Garfield. On the west side of the building is a West Plains police substation.


room, recognizable by the mural on the front. The program this month will be presented by Rebekah McKinney, Director of Library Services, and Janet McClure,
